


SESSION 3. Responsibility & Discipline

The Lord is my shepherd.



RESPONSIBILITY means...

- **1.** Accepting your obligations
- 2. Doing the right thing as the situation calls for it
- **3.** Accepting accountability for your actions

DISCIPLINE ≠ PUNISHMENT
DISCIPLINE = TO TEACH

The "rod of discipline" is used to **guide** and **protect** children.

PUNISHMENT & REWARDS OFTEN BACKFIRE SPONSIBILITY = CHOICES + CONSEQUENCES

LOGICAL CONSEQUENCES:

Discipline, provided by a parent or other authority, that is logically connected to misbehavior, to teach a child to behave within the limits of a situation

NATURAL CONSEQUENCES:

The results that occur from a child's behavior without any interference from another person

Guidelines PROBLEM-PREVENTION TALKS

- **1.** Begin with prayer.
- 2. Identify potential problems and risks.
- **3.** Share thoughts and feelings.
- **4.** Generate guidelines for behavior.
- **5.** Decide on logical consequences for violating guidelines (if necessary).
- **6.** Follow up later.

"CATCH 'EM BEING GOOD"

and use **POSITIVE "I" MESSAGES** to encourage more good behavior.
