


REVIEW / SESSION 3. Responsibility & Discipline



RESPONSIBILITY means...

- Accepting your obligations
- 2. Doing the right thing as the situation calls for it
- 3. Accepting accountability for your actions

DISCIPLINE ≠ PUNISHMENT DISCIPLINE = TO LEARN & REWARDS OFTEN BACKFIRE

Conseque **Guidelines for PROBLEM-PREVENTION TALKS**

- 1. Identify potential problems and risks.
- **2.** Share thoughts and feelings.
- **3.** Generate guidelines for behavior.
- **4.** Decide on logical consequences for violating guidelines (if necessary).
- **5.** Follow up later.

"CATCH 'EM BEING GOOD"

and use **POSITIVE "I" MESSAGES** to encourage more good behavior.

LOGICAL **CONSEQUENCES:**

Discipline, provided by a parent or other authority, that is logically connected to misbehavior, to teach a child to behave within the limits of a situation

NATURAL **CONSEQUENCES:**

The results that occur from a child's behavior without any interference from another person
